# TIRE STEWARDSHIP MANITOBA



Tire Stewardship Manitoba (TSM) operates a tires recycling program on behalf of the Manitoba tire industry.



TSM is committed to the protection of the Earth's environment and promotion of economic benefit for Manitoba through the sustainable management of all tires and tubes in Manitoba.

# 2020 CLAIM PROCEDURE UPDATE



TSM pays a 50-cent per tire incentive to registered Manitoba communities for scrap tires that are appropriately stored and collected for recycling from community waste disposal grounds or transfer stations.



Currently, to receive this incentive from TSM, community registrants submit their scrap tire collection claim form and hauler receipts to TSM for payment.

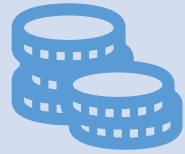


All claims for 2019 collections must be submitted to TSM and received by February 15, 2020 to be eligible for payment.



A new claim procedure beginning in 2020 simplifies the tire storage incentive payments for communities.

# NEW FOR 2020



For scrap tire collections occurring after December 31, 2019, TSM is introducing a “*claim free*” procedure. Community registrants will receive their storage incentive payment without the administrative requirement of submitting claim forms to TSM.



Based on data submitted by the Tire Recyclers to TSM, an annual payout/nil report and cheque payment for eligible tires collected in 2020 will be mailed from TSM to each registered Community by February 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021.



If there is an error with the report and payment from TSM, Community registrants can send TSM a request for an adjustment by providing copies of the collection receipts issued by haulers for the applicable period to validate the adjustment by March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2021.

# TSM COMMUNITY DEMONSTRATION AND INNOVATIONS GRANT PROGRAM

Tire Stewardship Manitoba offers one-time matching grants to communities and non-profit organizations for the use of recycled tire products in projects made from Manitoba tires.





## PROJECT FUNDING LEVELS

**Up to \$20,000** for Geotechnical, Road Construction, Landfill Systems, Rubber Asphalt Paving, Applied Research Projects

**Up to \$ 10,000** for Sports Field Infill Material, Playground Surface Material, Rubber Paving Material, Landscape Mulch

**Up to \$5,000** for Rubber Flooring Surface Mats

## WHO CAN APPLY?

Municipal corporations, local governments, including Northern Affairs and First Nation communities, non-profit organizations, educational and research institutions, youth groups and community associations are eligible to submit project proposals.





# SUBMISSION DEADLINE

**We are currently accepting applications for 2020**

Grant applications will be accepted on an open basis throughout the year. Applicants will be notified in writing of decisions made about their proposals.
