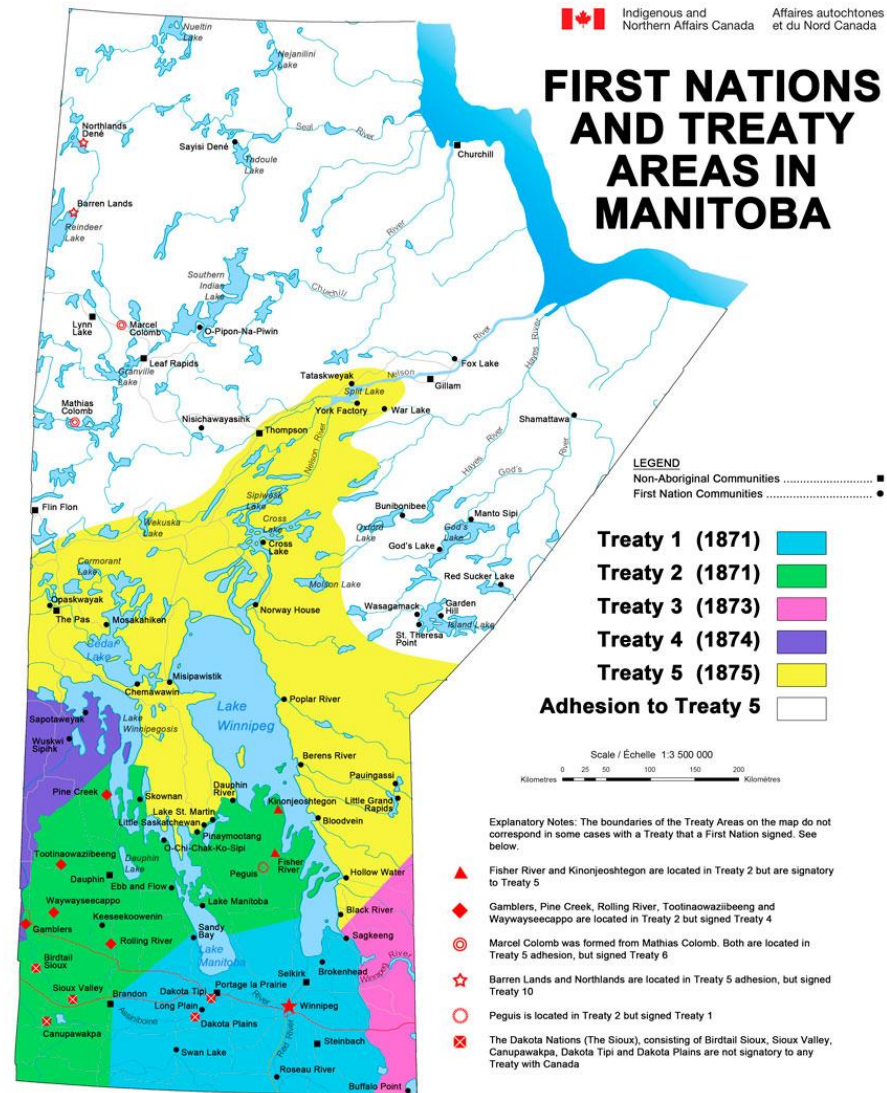




Welcomes you to the...
